

Wistron sees no impact of plant violence on company

Taiwanese company to continue manufacturing iPhone SE and iPhone 7 at its plant in Karnataka

Taiwanese major Wistron whose iPhone manufacturing plant was vandalised earlier this month over wage issues has said the incident will not cause significant impact to the company. "As the Narasapura facility is a new unit and the shipment quantity is still small, the incident will not cause significant impact to Wistron," it said in a statement to the Taiwan Stock Exchange. The company, which had pegged the damages during the riot at ₹50 crore, also manufactures Microsoft and Lenovo products at the Narasapura factory. Technology major Apple on Saturday said that it would not provide new business contracts to Wistron globally until the Taiwanese manufacturer completes all corrective actions at its Narasapura facility, around 60 km from Bengaluru. Wistron denied to comment on this development. The company will continue to manufacture iPhone SE and iPhone 7 models at the plant in Karnataka. "The programmes that have been initiated before the Narasapura issue remain," said a source. Wistron has admitted to lapses in payment of wages to employees and assured

full compensation to them. It has also removed its vice-president, Vincent Lee, who used to oversee the business in India. Expressing disappointment, Apple has said its focus is on making sure everyone in the supply chain is protected and treated with dignity and respect. Wistron, which employed only 2,000 employees until June, had added around 10,000 more employees within the next few months on a contractual basis, as Apple began gearing up for direct online sales of its flagship products in India. "This is a new facility and we recognise that we made mistakes as we expanded," said Wistron. An initial government report pointed out Wistron's HR department was not adequately set up with personnel of sound knowledge of labour laws. The factory has adopted two shifts of 12 hours per day system from October 4, with three breaks of half an hour each in each shift. "The confusion in the minds of the workers about their wage inclusive of overtime on account of the change in work pattern from 8 hour shift to 12 hour has not been addressed properly by the HR personnel in line with the legal provisions of law," said the report submitted by the department of factories, boilers, industrial safety & health.

Enough stocks, says Apple

Labour trouble at the Wistron plant in Bengaluru has not affected Apple Inc, which has enough stocks of iPhone SE 2020 and is in a position to divert the ones for export to the market in India. It will continue to manufacture the model in accordance with the existing order because only new orders have been put on hold. iPhone SE 2020 is one of the popular phones like Apple 11, which is the biggest seller in the domestic market.

Wistron will be manufacturing iPhone 12 Mini sometime in February and March next year. The model till then will be imported

Sources in the know say Apple Inc does not need to increase imports of iPhones due to the disruption at the Wistron factory. New orders will be given to Wistron, now under probation, only after it has settled its labour issues. Analysts say last year 75-80 per cent of its phones sold in India were manufactured in

the country and the bulk of those were iPhone SE, iPhone 11, and 10R. This year, analysts say, it expects to sell over 2 million phones, especially after smuggling fell dramatically due to restricted flights between Dubai and the US. Sources say a preliminary assessment has found that no

stocks of phones have been stolen. Only phones on assembly lines were attacked by workers, who have been agitating on labour issues. So sufficient stocks are available, and also the peak season for sales, which is November-December, is getting over. In response to a query, Apple Inc said it had nothing to

say on the matter. The company's biggest sellers in the country, iPhone 11, as well as the iPhone XR, will not face any hindrance because they are manufactured at the Foxconn plant in Chennai. And the iPhone 12 and Pro Max are imported. However, Foxconn is expected to manufacture iPhone 12 as part of Apple's plan. Wistron will be manufacturing iPhone 12 Mini sometime in February and March next year. The model till then will be imported. However, analysts say by then it is expected the Taiwanese company will solve its labour issues and the probation might no longer be applicable. As the iPhone 12 Mini pricing falls in the same bracket as that of iPhone 11, which is a much bigger phone and has caught the fancy of Indian consumers, its sales will not be less than 5 per cent of the total, analysts say.

Boeing hard-sells Super Hornet, tests it for Indian Navy carriers

India offered advanced Block III Super Hornet, with five major enhancements

The Boeing Company, which has sold the Indian military more aircraft types this decade than any other vendor, has made a strong play in another lucrative tender: the Indian Navy's acquisition of 57 multi-role carrier-based fighters (MRCBFs), worth an estimated \$7 billion.

The Super Hornet fighter, which Boeing is offering the Indian Navy, takes off from US aircraft carriers with the help of a catapult. Now, it has proven it can take off from a ski-jump, which Indian carriers use

Boeing announced on Monday, what has been rumoured for weeks: "Boeing and the US Navy recently concluded the 'ski jump' trials, demonstrating the... (F/A-18 Super Hornet's) suitability for Indian Navy's aircraft carriers." The F/A-18E/F Super Hornet, which Boeing is offering in the MRCBF tender, is primarily designed to take off from US aircraft carriers with the help of a catapult that accelerates the aircraft to take-off speed. In contrast, both Indian Navy carriers — the in-service INS Vikramaditya and the soon-to-be-commissioned INS Virat — are built on the Russian design philosophy. They launch aircraft from a ski-jump, without using a catapult. Boeing's confirmation that the Super Hornet has flown off a ski-jump is a statement that it is ready to operate

off existing Indian carriers. "The STOBAR, or Short Take-Off But Arrested Recovery test programme for F/A-18 Super Hornet was conducted at Patuxent River Naval Air Station, Maryland, US," Boeing stated on Monday. The Indian and US navies coordinate closely in the Indian Ocean region and the two defence ministries set up a joint working group (JWG) for aircraft carrier cooperation in 2015. US Navy designers have helped in framing specifications for India's proposed third carrier, which will launch its aircraft using a catapult, American style. "We have been working closely with the Indian Navy on the performance requirements for the MRCBF programme. The ski jump (trial) concluded goes a step further and will help validate the past

studies conducted by us on the ability of F/A-18 Super Hornet to operate effectively from the ski jump," said Boeing. Boeing revealed it has been conducting simulation analysis of ski-jump take-offs since 2018. During the actual trials, a Super Hornet was equipped with sensors to measure the extra strain involved. Then, take-offs were progressively conducted with heavier take-off weights and shorter take-off distances. Boeing has already built for the US Navy more than 570 Super Hornets and 160 Growlers — the Super Hornet variant equipped for electronic warfare. Now, it is developing an improved version called the Block III, which will start delivery next year. Ankur Kanaglekar, who is heading the Super Hornet's campaign in India, says

India will get the latest Block III fighters, with major improvements over the current variant. First, the F/A-18 Super Hornet will be offered to India in both a single seater (E-variant) and two-seater (F-variant) configuration, with both being carrier compatible. "The two-seater variant will allow Indian pilots to fly advanced missions that benefit from a second pilot. The Block III incorporates five major capability improvements. It has a longer airframe life of 10,000 hours, compared to the 6,000 hours of the Block II. It has 'conformal fuel tanks' that are built into the aircraft, increasing internal fuel carriage. It is less visible to enemy radar and has advanced networking architecture that allows digital interworking with the Navy's P-8I Poseidon maritime aircraft and other US-origin aircraft. Finally, Kanaglekar underlined that the US-India defence partnership would get a boost from having the Super Hornet on Indian carriers. "Built around Super Hornet, the two navies can potentially collaborate on operational readiness, carrier integration, technologies, pilot training, and development," he said. The US Navy has already contracted for 78 Block III Super Hornets, and Boeing has delivered the first two flight test aircraft this year. The delivery of operational fighters to the US Navy will begin next year.
